

Summary of Golf & Greens Committee meeting

February 19, 2024

Rhett went over the financials. Rounds were down in January, mainly due to weather conditions. Tarps were on the greens for 8 days in January; the course was closed for 12 days. Weather impacted revenue throughout January. February should be better.

Craig advised that he has a meeting about the master plan for the South & West courses on 3/27. New carts should be here around April 15th. It's necessary for all non-annual players to check in at the Pro Shop. The other exception to this is association players (WGA, MGA, WLN).

A question was asked about whether we should be marketing the fact that we're the #1-rated course? Per Craig, yes, we will.

Also, the golf forum in next Monday, February 26th at 1:00 pm. Topics will include the course stats for 2023, remodel project, Ryan's agronomy calendar, and tournaments through August. **Craig encouraged all association members to attend.**

Ryan reported that from February 19th-March 8, the courses will be aerated and cleaned up. They've started reducing the height of all turf, and moving sand around the bunkers. About 75 tons of sand is on order for the bunkers. The course will be closed on March 18th for slow-release fertilizer application, which should last 3-4 months. They will be starting the process of replacing sprinkler heads and will probably have about 100 flags on 2 holes at a time. **Please don't pull the flags!!**

Old Business

- Regarding Play Card expiration – previously if a card is used up by November 1st, a player can be charged the same fee as before. This was voted on by the Board.

New Business

- The Spring tour date is April 15th at 5:30 pm The Fall date is September 30th at 5:00 (subject to change)
- There was a motion to recommend allowing cigars to be sold in the Pro Shop. Motion carried
